AIRWORTHINESS CIRCULAR

Program Manager Airworthiness Roles

- 1. Purpose.** This Airworthiness Circular (AC) provides standard Program Manager (PM) signature authority for airworthiness (AW) products.
- 2. Scope.** This AC applies to AW products.
- 3. Attachments.** Attachment 1: Airworthiness Roles Per Program Type & Associated Products
- 4. Cancellations.** Not Applicable. This is the first issuance of this AC.

- 6. Background.**

AFI 63-101/20-101, paragraph 5.1.5.3, requires PMs for aircraft systems to obtain the required AW approvals in accordance with DAFI 62-601. AFPD 62-6, paragraph 3.1.3, requires air system PMs (as defined in AFPD 63-1/20-1) ensure air systems are designed and managed in compliance with AW requirements. DAFI 62-601, paragraph 2.9, documents the PM's roles and responsibilities in executing the AW process.
- 7. Discussion.** The USAF Technical AW Authority requires PM coordination on AW products as defined in Table 1.
- 8. Recommendations.** Program Offices should follow this guidance for PM coordination and issuance of AW products.
