

EZZ Template 160-1: Military Type Certificate Instructions

- 1 MANUFACTURER/MDS (Program Office): Airframe prime contractor and/or the designated MDS. The Program Office is who the MTC is being issued to.
- 2 PROJECT TITLE: Project title or brief description of the project; should match ACT, if appropriate.
- 3 ISSUE DATE: The date of issuance.
- 4 EXPIRATION: Date, Flight Hours, and Actual Flight Hours.
- 5 SERIAL/TAIL NUMBER(S)/CONFIGURATION: Provide information identifying the aircraft authorized for flight in accordance with this MTC and the pertinent configuration change, if applicable. If all of the necessary information does not fit in this block it can be entered in block 10, "Additional information".
- 6 TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Additional conditions may be defined by the TAA or DTA.
- 7 SIGNATURE: Signature, name, and title of the TAA or DTA. Electronic signature is acceptable.
- 8 SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:
 - 8.1 MANDATORY:
 - 8.1.1 Baseline AW Approval
 - 8.1.2 Compliance Report
 - 8.1.3 Previous AW Approval(s), as applicable: Applicable configurations with non-reportable MFR or MTCs should be listed.
 - 8.1.4 Configuration Description
 - 8.1.5 TOs (preliminary TOs are acceptable for flight test)
 - 8.1.6 Risk Acceptance: All Risk Acceptance Memos should be included. This should include all previously identified risks and newly identified risks.
 - 8.2 AS APPLICABLE
 - 8.2.1 Intended usage, limitations, and restrictions (if not included in Technical Orders)
 - 8.2.2 Supporting AW Approval(s) (MTC, MFR)
 - 8.2.3 Flight Test Plan
- 9 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Add additional information that did not fit in previous blocks
- 10 DISTRIBUTION STATEMENT: The distribution statement for this document IAW DODD 5230.24 is on the template; the program office should update the date.
- 11 PAGE NUMBER: Ensure the page count is correct. Also, delete the pages that are not part of the MTC.
